

Wortschatz mit -ing

◆ Verben + -ing (Gerund)

1. admit (zugeben)

- He admitted **cheating** in the test.
- She admitted **lying** to her parents.

2. avoid (vermeiden)

- She avoided **answering** the question.
- He avoids **talking** about the problem.

3. consider (in Erwägung ziehen)

- They are considering **moving** to another city.
- Have you considered **applying** for the job?

4. enjoy (genießen)

- I enjoy **reading**.
- She enjoys **playing** volleyball.

5. finish

- He finished **doing** his homework.
- She finished **writing** the email.

6. keep (weiter machen, nicht aufhören)

- She kept **asking** questions.
- He keeps **interrupting** me.

7. mind (was ausmachen)

- Do you mind **opening** the window?
- I don't mind **helping** you.

8. suggest (vorschlagen)

- She suggested **going** to the cinema.
- He suggested **studying** together.

9. practise (BE) / practice (AE)

- She practises **speaking** English.
- He practised **playing** the guitar.

10. imagine (sich vorstellen, mimaginieren)

- Can you imagine **living** abroad?
- I can't imagine **doing** that.

◆ 2. Feste Ausdrücke + -ing (sehr beliebt in Prüfungen)

be worth (wert sein)

- It's worth **trying**.
- The film is worth **watching**.

look forward to (freuen auf)

(Achtung: to ist hier Präposition!)

- I'm looking forward to **seeing** you.
- She looks forward to **starting** her new job.

be used to (gewohnt sein)

- I'm used to **getting up** early.
- He isn't used to **working** so much.

can't help (kann nicht lassen)

- I can't help **laughing**.
- She couldn't help **crying**.

◆ 3. Nach Präpositionen → immer -ing

Das ist extrem prüfungsrelevant:

- After **finishing** school...
- Before **leaving** the house...
- Without **saying** goodbye...
- By **working** hard...
- Instead of **playing** games...
